- **Purpose of Scholarship**

The Tennessee Congress of Parents and Teachers established and maintains the Scholarship Fund to give financial assistance to young people who need additional funding to obtain a bachelor's degree toward the goal of becoming a teacher or working in a child-related field such as: education, medicine, law or any new field of child related studies.

- **Value**

Each scholarship provides a one-time \$2,000 non-renewable award. As many scholarships as the fund permits will be awarded each year.

- **Requirements for Scholarship**

Applicant must be a graduating senior from a Tennessee high school interested in teaching or other child-related vocation. The applicant or a family member of the applicant must be an active member of a PTA/PTSA in good standing.

- The applicant will be considered on the following points:
 - Essay
 - Academics
 - Sincerity of purpose / personality
 - Motivation
 - Community Involvement
 - Recommendations
- **The original plus three (3) copies of the complete application packet must be received by the Tennessee PTA at the address above ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1ST.** The complete application packet must include the following:
 - Completed application form
 - Principal / Guidance Counselor form
 - Essay that is 500 words or less, typed and double-spaced
 - Two (2) letters of recommendation
 - Official transcript
- Photograph on original application only (will not be returned)
- The applicant must enroll in a two- or four-year Tennessee college or university for a teaching or child-related degree.
- ***Failure to disclose any requested information will result in immediate disqualification.***

- When the review process is complete, an award notification letter from Tennessee PTA will be mailed to the recipient and principal. A letter informing the college / university of the award and remittance will be mailed by Tennessee PTA upon verification of completed student registration.
