- A descriptive narrative in addition with a limit of 500 words must be included which describes the following:
 - The efforts made to build a more diverse PTA membership and/or board that is inclusive and reflective of its community.
 - The program(s) and practices that focused on (i) promoting the elimination of bias, prejudice and misunderstanding and (ii) promoting support, inclusion and understanding within your community. Include information on activities conducted, target audience, and actions the PTA took to address the issue(s).
 - ➤ The efforts made to become acquainted with diverse community groups/leaders in the community and to collaborate with them to increase parent, family and community engagement.
 - ➤ The efforts to educate your PTA members and/or leaders to the needs, cultural beliefs, traditions and family structures of the population served.
 - The outcomes and impact of your efforts including the evaluation methods. Describe how your PTA plans to continue to promote and sustain these efforts. Share evidence of the impact (qualitative and quantitative) that these programs and practices have had on your PTA, school and/or community.

Winners will receive recognition during the annual Tennessee PTA meeting.
