

## Voucher Position Statement

The Tennessee PTA advocates that funds raised by general taxation for educational purposes should be administered by public officials and should not be used to support privately-operated schools or any non-public school or education program through tuition tax credits, education savings accounts, vouchers, block grants, or other means because of the negative impact to the public schools of the state and nation. The Tennessee PTA stands behind fully funding public education for all students.
